Update on Radiation Monitoring & Assessment Fees

Effective: October 1, 2025

The Radiation Protection Authority (RPA), under the Ministry of Technology and Science, is updating its fee structure as per Statutory Instrument No. 52 of 2025 to strengthen compliance and enhance our mandate to protect the public, workers, and the environment from ionizing radiation hazards.

Key Regulatory Changes

These adjustments are designed to improve the accuracy and effectiveness of our monitoring services.



Strengthened Compliance

Enhanced measures to ensure greater safety and adherence to national regulations.



Fees Per Product

A shift from a per-vehicle basis to a per-product basis for a more accurate assessment.



Adjusted Fee Structure

Transit, import, and export fees have been updated to reflect current operational costs.

Billing Model Update

The fundamental basis for fee calculation has changed to provide fairer and more precise assessments.

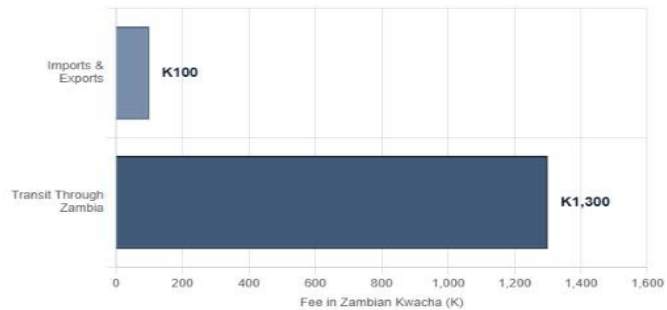

New Fee Structure Comparison

The new fees show a significant difference between local clearance and international transit, reflecting the varied levels of assessment required.



Mandatory Payment Process

All payments must be processed exclusively through the official government channel to ensure proper logging and compliance.
