The Ionising Radiation Protection (General) (Amendment) Regulations, 2025

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section 46 of the Ionising Radiation Protection Act, 2005, the following Regulations are made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Ionising Radiation Protection (General) (Amendment) Regulations, 2025, and shall be read as one with the Ionising Radiation Protection (General) Regulations, 2011, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 2 of the principal Regulations is amended by the insertion of the following new definition in the appropriate place in alphabetical order:

"product" has the meaning assigned to the word in the Standards Act, 2017;.

3. The Sixth Schedule to the principal Regulations is amended by the insertion of the following new items immediately after item 08:

09 Radiation screening of radioactive material

(a) radiation screening of imported or exported byproducts of mining activities, building materials and construction materials containing naturally occurring radioactive materials or contamination, per product
